Welcome !

Dourdan, is the capital of the Hurepoix area. This friendly town is peopled with 10.000 inhabitants. Between the forest and the Beauce valley. It is the perfect example of the balance between nature and urbanization: it's a typical country town!



Built on the banks of the Orge, Dourdan developed from the gallo-roman period, thanks to pottery workshops in plenty (three potteries are present on the coat of arms of the town).



Located on the Wheat Route linking La Beauce to Paris, Dourdan was a strategically place which played a part in many wars of French History. Ancient cradle of the royal power, Dourdan is characterized by a powerful stronghold, built in the town centre by Philippe Auguste in 1220. This stronghold is a remarkable example of military architecture which crossed ages. It was the estate of great people of the French kingdom : Blanche de Castille, Saint-Louis, the duke de Berry, the family of Orléans and the family of Eureux.

The Castle (XIIIth century)



The castle of Dourdan, made by Philippe Auguste in 1222, was built on the ruins of one of Hughes Capet's Motte and Baileys castles. Inspired from the castle of Louvre (which was unfortunately destroyed since then), Dourdan's stronghold is famous for its regular plan and its defensive structures, such as its keep placed in the corner, its circular towers and its ditch. This castle is the last Philippian castle still remaining nowadays.

After the religious wars, Henry the 4th rebuilt the ruined castle. From 1672, this castle was turned into a prison. Many convicts stayed there. Two centuries later, the castle was bought and bequeathed to Joseph Guyot in 1864. Guyot spent all his life restoring and changing the prison into a home.

Dourdan castle has been a listed monument since 1964.

The Museum

In the courtyard of the castle stands the museum of Dourdan, in place of the 18th century salt granary. Today, this museum exhibits many collections which present the history and the life of the city of Dourdan: archeological pottery, the fortified castle's model, items from the old main hospital of Dourdan, embossments, paintings and sculptures from the 16th to the 20th centuries.

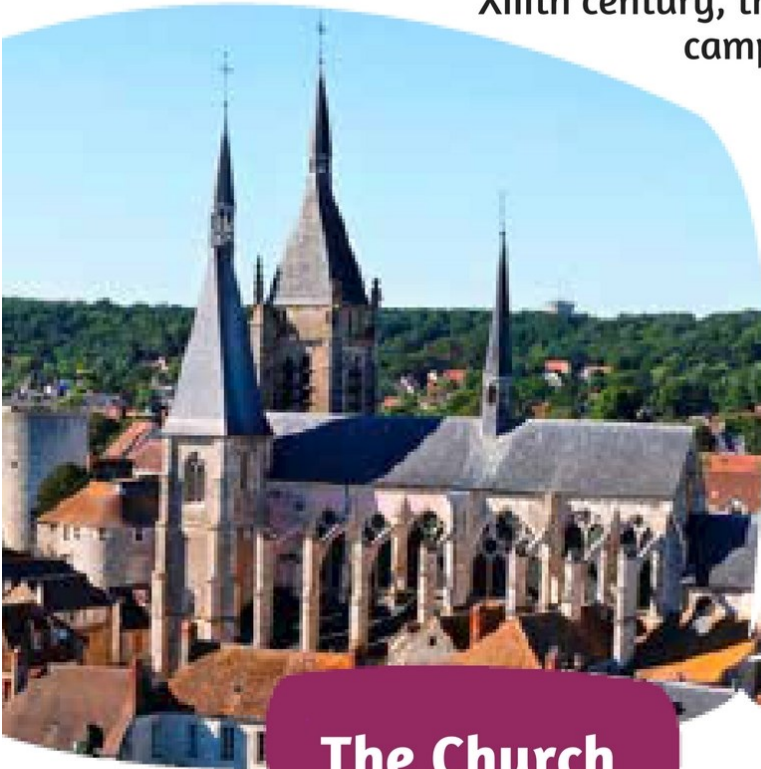




Discover Dourdan



Saint-Germain L'Auxerrois (XII–XVIIIth centuries) At the beginning of the XIIIth century, the second work construction campaign started:



The Church

pillars, triforium, and clerestories were built. In the XIIth century and at the beginning of the XIVth century: the building was completed by the nave's pillars and the entrance. During the hundred year's war, the town was besieged by the count of Salisbury and the church suffered damages as well as during the French wars of religion (roof torched, stained glass windows and spires destroyed, bells melted down to become cannonballs...). Saint-Germain L'Auxerrois (XII–XVIIIth From 1790, the priory gradually lost its incomes.

Finally, the church was modified one last time in the XIXth century. This building is imposing : 50 metres long and 18 metres high and one of the spire is 50 metres high.

The church saint Germain de l'Auxerrois, located down-town dominates the entire valley. The church Saint Germain de l'Auxerrois is characterised by two types of architecture: primitive gothic architecture and Flamboyant gothic architecture. In 1150, first construction work started with the construction of a new chancel.



The City Walls

The layout of the ramparts shows where the fortifications of the town were. The ramparts were 1700 metres long, possessed a round path and 18 towers with arrow slits.

There were 4 main gates called : la Porte de Paris, de Chartres, d'Etampes and de Corbreuse. The Duque De Berry ordered the construction of the ramparts : indeed, the use of cannons was spreading and Dourdan needed a new sort of fortification. Nowadays, the major part of the ramparts is still surrounding the town.



The Market hall

The first Market hall of Dourdan was built in the XIIIth century and had a huge roof structure. In order to save the damaged market, restoring work was undertaken until the 1850's. The hall is 38 metres long. The market and several events take place there.

L'Hôtel-Dieu

L'hotel-Dieu (near the church Saint Germain L'auxerrois and the castle) sheltered the pilgrims and the poor.



It was built in the XIIIth century, around 1220. It was entirely rebuilt between 1766 and 1770. Donations from the Nobility and the Bourgeoisie contributed to its development. It was a hospital until 1970, which was relocated on the outskirts of the town. Nowadays it is a rest-home.

The Parterre's Castle

In 1725, Michel Jacques, the king adviser and the bailiff of Dourdan, ordered the construction of the castle. In 1739, Mme de Vertillac, (the wife of Dourdan's gouverneur, the count de Vertillac)

a brilliant woman who attached importance to literature and philosophy bought the castle. In 1791, Le parterre was requisitioned by the republican army as barracks. The victories of the republic were celebrated in the gardens. In 1809, the castle was sold to the town: the town hall became the only owner of the castle in 1863. The park is still one of the favorite places to celebrate special events.





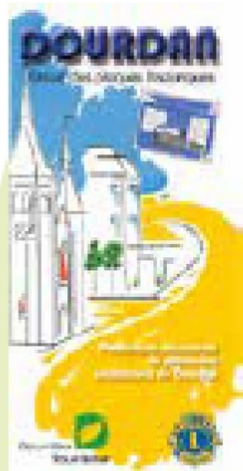
XIXth century houses

The construction of houses out of the city walls was due to the town's development at the end of the XIXth century. Those houses were built for the new upper middle class.

Moreover, during the second Empire, architecture and construction developed significantly. This development, due to mass-produced materials, offered various types of houses. Specialized publishers, settled in Dourdan for more than a century, spread architecture reviews and technical books which enabled architects to build manors everywhere in France.

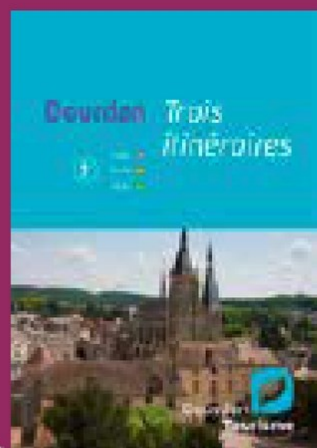
Geological stroll

Charles Peguy
In June 1912 and July 1913, Charles Peguy had done twice the route between Palaiseau and Chartres on foot in 4 days.

The Parterre

The Parterre - Parc François Mitterrand

In the 18th century, Michel Lévy, councilor of the king built the castle of Parterre and made draw a garden "à la française" in the tradition of Le Nôtre. Originally private, the garden opens to the public at the end of the XVIIIth century and becomes a place of celebration and gathering for the Dourdannais.

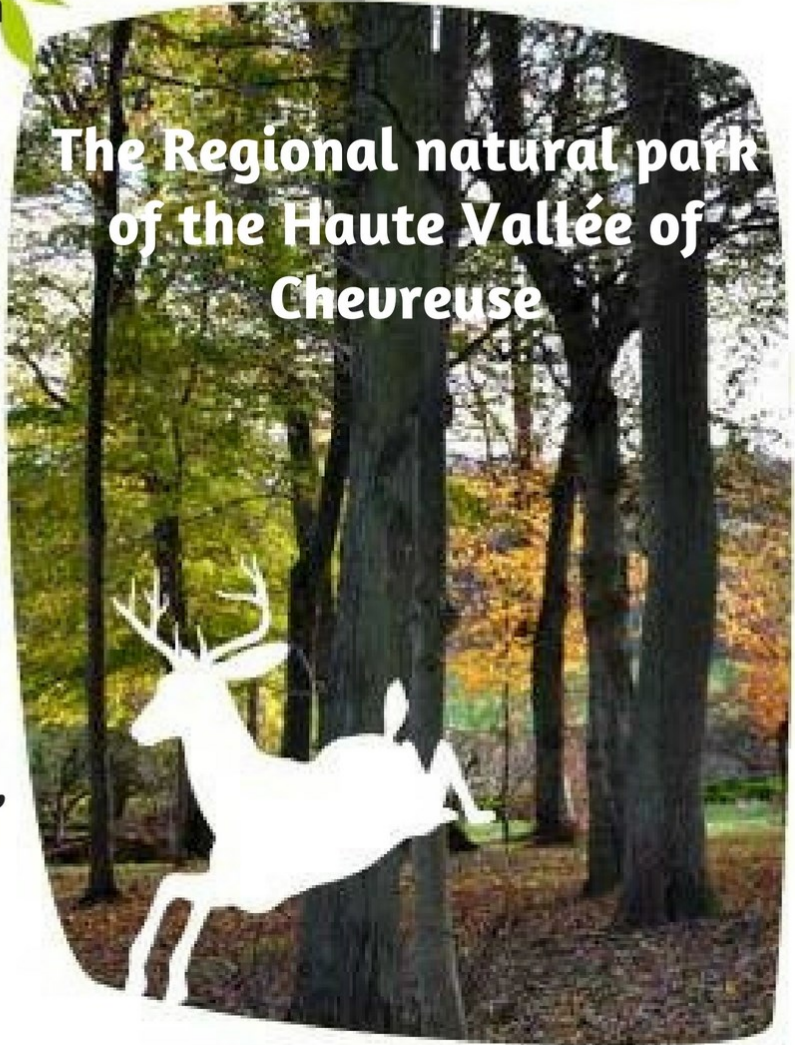

Along the Orge river



The ancient royal forest of Dourdan is divided into two parts by the Orge Valley (Saint Arnoult and L'Oüye) and spread over 1600 hectares. Various trees exist in the forest such as chestnut trees, ash trees, beech trees, birches, hornbeams and oaks : the famous "chêne des 6 frères" in particular which was a pilgrimage place (its trunk is said to be full of holy water). Various animals and birds are also present such as stags, roes, wild boars, squirrels, badgers, hedgehogs, robins, cuckoos, tits and woodpeckers.

The Regional natural park of the Haute Vallée of Chevreuse



This park is characterized by contrasting landscape where steep-sided valleys alternate with cultivated uplands and hills wooded. The Chevreuse valley, the wood of Yvelines and the uplands of Hurepoix are a part of rural territories and forest the most remarkable in Ile de France. You will see rustic landscape, farms, mills, churches, abbeys, parks and gardens, castles and picturesque villages which enrich the park. Dourdan and its historical and estate incorporates the park as a city gate.

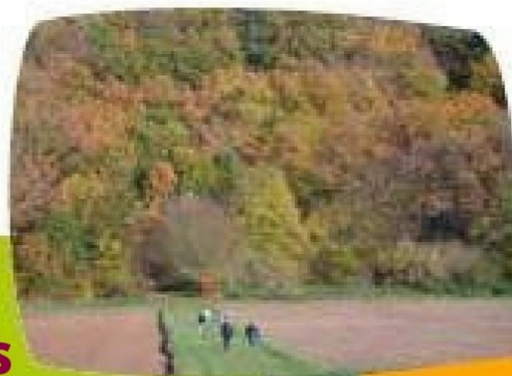


The ponds of the « Fontaines Bouillantes »

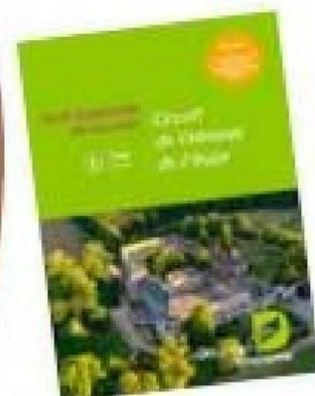


A walk in the woods

Dourdan is the starting point of many hiking paths, easy to get to thanks to the highway and the railway station (RER C line).



The tourist Information center offers and put at use two different hiking paths : “circuit de l’Abbaye de l’Ouille” and “Circuit des Fontaines Bouillantes” of 6 or 8 km, in order to discover the forest, its remarkable trees and l’Abbaye de l’Ouille. For the best hikers other trails are suggested to cross all the area and surrounding villages. A very precise map of Dourdan’s forest is also available to your request.

At 4 km : the Abbey of the Oujë

She was build in 1163 by Louis VII aka the young or the god-fearing, to thank the sky for permitting him to hear the call of his companions the day he lost him-self in this forest. The land was given by Louis VII The young to the monks of Grandmont. Several Kings, in-cluding Louis IX, are the protectors and the benefac-tors of the Priory of the Oujë that was damaged by the war of religion at the XVI century. In 1763, she becomes an abbey Benectine whom owners have succed to each other until 1945, date in which the Ur-sulines bought the Priory and moved in.



At 10 km : The Castle of the marais The Val Saint-Germain

After crossing the grid, you wiull find yourself in an al-ley of plane trees. The same one Chateaubriand said about : « the Mash didn't lose it's alley of plane trees during the revolution » and in which the fabulist Florian wrote that in going out of this alley, he was going out of paradise. Then at your right you will see a building ocher pink, the oldest of the place, it use to be a mill. There is often expositions.



At 12 km : The House of Elsa Triolet Aragon Saint-Arnoult-en-Yuelines

The visit of the Mill permit to enter in the life and artwork of the two witters.Expositions, conferences, readings and singing are waiting for you at the Mill.



At 18 km : Rambouillet Space

The nature, decked of feathers, hair and leaves, invites you to a big show strong in emotions.

Discover the ra pacious, get close to deers and aurochs. Surprise doe and boars and get in touch with the spire of the trees. At the rambouillet space, come to feel all the sensations of the forest.

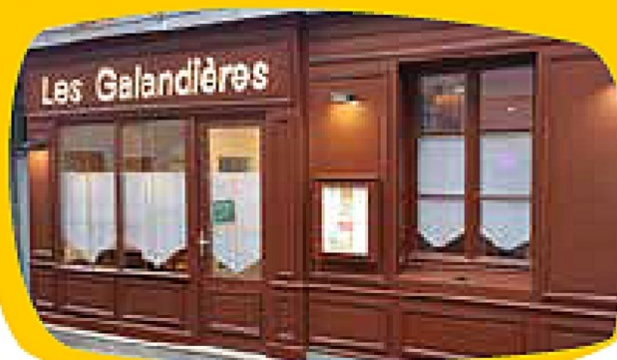
